

Information Request Information Art.13

(pursuant to and for the purposes of art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 679/16)

The Data Controller of the personal data listed below, pursuant to art. 13 of EU Regulation no. 679/16 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter "Regulation") informs that it will process the data for the purposes and in the manner indicated below.

1. TYPE OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED

The data processed by the Data Controller are:

- 1.3. Judicial personal data: 1 ÿ Criminal convictions/offences
- 1.4. Type of possible profiling: 1 ÿ professional performance; 2 ÿ economic situation; 3 ÿ health; 4 ÿ preferences personal; 5 ÿ interests; 6 ÿ reliability; 7 ÿ behavior; 8 ÿ location/movements.

The data processing will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation as specified below.

2. SOURCE OF THE PERSONAL DATA SUBJECT TO PROCESSING.

The personal data subject to processing are those collected from the interested party.

3. PURPOSE OF DATA COLLECTION (art.13 par.1 letter c Regulation)

- 3.1. **(Corporate Investment Information)** This purpose is intended to inform you how we want to process your data to provide corporate information for the purpose of possible future equity and/or bond investments. The data will be retained for the time strictly necessary, not exceeding 6 months from the last relationship (plus 30 days to delete). For this purpose, consent is not required pursuant to **art.6 par. 1 letter b** of the Regulation (pre-contractual measures). The data used for this purpose are all those indicated above in point 1.1.



- 3.2. **(General statistics)** This purpose is intended to inform you how we want to manage your data to carry out general statistics (e.g. "pseudo-anonymous") in aggregate form for the sole purpose of improving the quality of the services/products offered. The data will be stored for the strictly necessary time, not exceeding 6 months.

Particular attention has been paid to minimization of the data used for this purpose. Where this is not entirely possible, the data used will only be those indicated in point 1.1 in nos. 1 and 2.

4. LEGAL BASIS FOR THE PROCESSING (art.13 par.1 letter c of the Regulation)

The legal basis is explained in the individual purposes referred to in point 3.

5. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION - CONSEQUENCES OF REFUSAL TO CONSENT (art.13 par.2 letter e of the Regulation)

In compliance with art.13 par.2 letter e of the Regulation, see the specific purposes for information regarding the legal obligation, contract or requirement to conclude a contract. If the interested party does not intend to provide the personal data above, the consequence would be the impossibility of establishing or continuing the relationship between the parties.

6. RECIPIENTS WHO MAY BECOME AWARE OF YOUR PERSONAL DATA (art.13 par.1 letter e of the Regulation)

The categories of subjects who may become aware of your personal data are: authorized persons (employees), Data Processors (suppliers) of the Data Controller, recipients (customers), DPO where appointed, any control bodies. Public authorities responsible for controls or legal obligations.

7. TRANSFER OF PERSONAL DATA (art. 13, par.1 letter f of the Regulation)

In the event of data transfer outside the EU, the Data Controller hereby ensures that the transfer will take place in compliance with Articles 44 et seq. of the GDPR and the applicable legal provisions, stipulating, if necessary, agreements for the transfer of personal data established in third countries that do not guarantee an adequate level of protection of personal data.

8. METHODS OF TREATMENT

The processing will be carried out in paper form and/or in electronic form or in any case with the aid of computerised tools.

9. RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY (art. 13, par.1 letter b of the Regulation)

Articles 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23 of the Regulation grant the interested party the exercise of specific rights, including:

- 9.1. art.12 Information, communications and transparent methods for exercising the rights of the interested party;
- 9.2. art.13 Information to be provided where personal data are collected from the data subject;
- 9.3. art.14 Information to be provided where the personal data have not been obtained from the data subject;
- 9.4. art.15 Right of Access: right to obtain from the data controller confirmation as to whether or not personal data processing is underway.

- 9.5. art.16 Right to rectification: right to obtain from the data controller the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him;
- 9.6. art.17 Right to erasure ('right to be forgotten'): right to obtain from the data controller the erasure of personal data concerning him or her;

- 9.7. art.18 Right to limit processing: right to obtain from the owner a limited processing of your data when you contest the accuracy of the personal data, when the processing is unlawful and if you have objected to the processing;
- 9.8. art.19 Right to receive notification from the Data Controller in the event of rectification or erasure of personal data or limitation of the treatment;
- 9.9. art.20 Right to data portability: obtain data portability, i.e. receive them from a data controller, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and transmit them to another data controller without impediments;
- 9.10. art.21 Right to object: to object to processing at any time, even in the case of processing for marketing purposes direct;
- 9.11. art.22 Automated decision-making relating to natural persons, including profiling;
- 9.12. art.23 Limitation.

The documents are available at the operational headquarters of the Data Controller (reported in box A), who, as above, undertakes to guarantee the exercise of the rights. The interested party may lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority (art. 13, par. 2 letter d of the Regulation), following the procedures and indications published on the Authority's official website at www.garanteprivacy.it. In exercising the rights referred to in arts. 12-23 of the Regulation, the interested party may confer, in writing, a delegation or power of attorney to natural persons or associations. Requests may be forwarded to the data controller or to the DPO, if appointed, via the email addresses reported in boxes A and B.

10. DURATION OF TREATMENT (art.13 par.2 letter a Regulation)

The data processing will last as indicated in the individual purposes, with an increase of 30 days for technical reasons. The conservation for a longer period is reserved in case of defense in court of the Owner for the entire duration of the dispute.

11. DATA CONTROLLER (art.13 par.1 letter a Regulation)

12. DATA PROTECTION OFFICER (DPO) (art.13 par.1 letter b) Regulation)
